



# ABERDOVEY GOLF CLUB

These rules, conditions and provisions are in place to keep you, the club staff, volunteers and members of the club as safe as possible.

DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU HAVE ANY SYMPTOMS FOR COVID-19. THE MAIN SYMPTOMS INCLUDE: A HIGH TEMPERATURE, A NEW/CONTINUOUS COUGH OR A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE. IF YOU DEVELOP SYMPTOMS DURING THE ROUND, CONTACT THE CLUB MANAGER IMMEDIATELY.

## 1. Before the Event

- Any players travelling from outside the UK will be required to follow quarantine rules set by the UK Government that are in place at time of entry into the UK for those countries that are not-exempt. For an up-to-date list of those countries please consult the UK Government website. All players are to comply with relevant government guidelines, including restrictions in place within local lockdown areas.
- By arriving to play, you are confirming that on the day of attendance you do not have symptoms of Covid-19 (including a temperature) and have not knowingly been exposed to anyone who does have Covid-19.
- Competitors should travel separately unless part of an extended household.
- Players should bring their own PPE and hand sanitiser. **Face masks must be worn at all times whilst inside the Professional's Shop and in the downstairs areas in the Clubhouse.**
- Please respect 2 metre social distancing at all times.

## 2. Upon Arrival

- Players are asked to arrive no earlier than 60 minutes before their tee time.
- Change your shoes in the car park.
- A practice area is available for practice and warm-up no more than 60 minutes before a player's tee-time. Use own balls. Alternatively, two practice nets are available for use.
- Toilet facilities are available in the clubhouse but as the clubhouse is not open, there is limited access to these facilities. All players must follow the one-way system implemented at the club.
- Toilet facilities are available on the course, please use the hand sanitiser in place.
- Please note that there is a maximum of 4 people allowed in the Professional's Shop at any one time.

## 3. Beginning Your Round

- Players should make their way to the 1st tee 10 minutes before their tee-time, when the group in front has left the teeing area.
- There will be an official starter in the starter's hut and a scorecard should be collected from there. Mark your own scorecard (do not exchange cards with any of your playing partners).
- There will be no printed information available such as rules sheets, pin positions etc. Local Rules are printed on the scorecard and the temporary local rules are as follows:

### Pin Positions on Greens:

Red flag – Front  
Yellow flag – Middle  
White flag – Back

## 4. During Your Round

- Please do not use any on course furniture, this includes all on course bins and ball washers. Please respect the course and greens staff and take all your rubbish away with you.
- Should you complete a hole and the group in front have not vacated the next tee, please wait away from the tee until safe to approach the teeing area.
- Flagsticks must remain in the hole and not be removed or touched. Pipe lagging is in each hole cup to avoid the ball dropping all the way to the bottom of the hole.
- Bunker rakes have been removed from the course, so please smooth over your footprints as best as possible using your foot or club. Preferred lies in operation in bunkers as above.
- In the event of a suspension of play resulting in players being instructed to leave the golf course, all players MUST go straight to their cars and wait for further instruction.

## 5. Completing Your Round

- Upon completion of your round, please confirm your scores verbally with your playing partners and then proceed to the Pro's shop window to call out your scores for inputting into the computer. Verbally confirming your score with the staff will be considered the official point of return of your scorecard. There is no requirement to return any physical scorecards.
