COMPETITIONS FORMAT & ADMINISTRATION FOR 2021

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Committee is responsible for setting out the conditions of all MWCGA competitions and these will be reviewed on an annual basis. The Committee has authority to amend a competition format to meet exceptional circumstances.
- 1.2 All MWCGA competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules and Conditions of Competition as shall be approved by the Committee.

2. ENTRY TO COMPETITIONS

- 2.1 To participate in all MWCGA competitions, competitors must be:
 - a Full Member of MWCGA by purchasing an annual County Card and
 - their club must also be affiliated to MWCGA by paying the appropriate annual fee.
- 2.2 The exception to this is Associate Membership when players of clubs not affiliated to MWCGA may enter competitions (but not the County Championship or play in County matches) by paying the appropriate fee to become an Associate Member (details available under Rules & Constitution on the Association web site) www.mwcga.co.uk.
- 2.3 Competitors must be an amateur golfer having an official WHS Handicap Index in order to compete in all MWCGA competitions. Unless otherwise stated, the maximum Handicap Index will be 54.
- 2.4 The competition entry form and entry fee should be sent to the MWCGA Competitions Secretary. Closing date for entries will be 14 days prior to the competition date. Late entries will be accepted where tee times are available and subject to the conditions of the competition.

3. CANCELLATION POLICY

3.1 Competition start sheets will be published 10 days prior to the competition date (on the MWCGA website and by email to the Club Delegate). Cancellations will be accepted and entry fees refunded for cancellations made up to 10 days prior to the competition day.

4. COMPETITION TIES

4.1 In the event of a tie in all the strokeplay and stableford 18 hole competitions the winner(s) shall be decided on the lowest score for the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole.

5. PRIZE ALLOCATION

5.1 Prizes will be allocated in proportion to the number of entries received for each competition and number of players in the appropriate division if applicable. 60% of entry fees received for each competition will be allocated to prizes with 40% being retained in County funds. The percentage amount will be reviewed annually.

6. TWO'S COMPETITIONS

6.1 Due to the Covid-19 restrictions it is unlikely that 2s competitions will be held in 2021.

Host Clubs will be encouraged to organise a 2's competition. Number of balls available dependent on the income raised and the cost of balls. Balls to be divided between all players scoring a two on any hole. MWCGA policy is that if there are no two's scored, balls will be divided between all players scoring a birdie and/or eagle on any hole.

7. COUNTY CARD COMPETITIONS

7.1 The number, format and details of the County Card competitions will be reviewed annually and published in a booklet form. The County Card booklet will be made available, for purchase, to all members of MWCGA Affiliated Clubs at the beginning of each golfing season through the Club's County Delegate. The details of County Card competitions are set out below:

7.1 Spring Teams of Three

Date: Usually on a weekend during March

Format: Teams of Three, Stableford – Handicap Allowance - 85% of Course Handicap for

each player

Scoring: Two best scores on each hole to count

Prizes: For best team of three and other prizes in relation to the number of entries received.

Trophy: No trophy

7.2 Spring Meeting

Date: Usually in April on a weekend if permitted by the host club

Format: Silver Division - Individual Strokeplay – Handicap Allowance - 95% of Course Handicap

Bonze Division – Individual Strokeplay - Handicap Allowance - 95% of Course Handicap

The Silver Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap Index of 20.0 or less and the Bronze Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap

Index of 20.1 or above.

Scoring: Gross score

Prizes: Best Gross & Best Nett

Silver Division prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division; **Bronze Division** prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division;

No money value for team prize.

Trophies: Judith James Trophy Best Gross score

Meg Bowen Salver Best Nett score after applied Handicap allowance

Team Shield Awarded to Club with the best 3 nett aggregate scores

7.3 Stableford

Date: Usually in May on a weekend if permitted by the host club

Format: Individual Stableford – Handicap Allowance - 95% of Course Handicap

Scoring: Stableford system

Prizes: Overall best stableford score

Silver Division prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division; **Bronze Division** prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division; The Silver Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap Index of 20.0 or less and the Bronze Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap

Index of 20.1 or above.

Trophy: Welshpool Crystal Best overall stableford points scored

7.4 Seniors' Meeting

Date: Usually in June on a weekday or weekend subject to the host club **Qualification**: Open to all players aged 50 or over on the date of the competition **Format**: Individual Stableford – Handicap Allowance - 95% of Course Handicap

Scoring: Stableford system

Prizes: Best overall stableford points scored;

Division A (age 50-59) prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division; **Division B** (age 60-69) prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division;

Division C (age 70+) prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division;

Seniors' Trophy Best overall stableford points scored.

7.5 Summer Teams of Three

Trophy:

Date: Usually in July on a weekend if permitted by the host club

Format: Teams of Three, Stableford - Handicap Allowance - 85% of Course Handicap for

each player

Scoring: Two best scores on each hole to count

Prizes: For best team of three and other team prizes in relation to the number of entries

received

Trophy: No trophy

7.6 Autumn Meeting

Date: Usually weekday in September or on a weekend if permitted by the host club

Format: Silver Division - Individual Strokeplay – Handicap Allowance -95% of Course Handicap

Bonze Division – Individual Strokeplay - Handicap Allowance -95% of Course Handicap The Silver Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap Index of 20.0 or less and the Bronze Division is for players with an official WHS Handicap Index of 20.1 or

above.

Scoring: Gross score

Prizes: Best Gross & Best Nett;

Silver Division prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division; **Bronze Division** prizes in proportion to number of entries in the Division;

Trophies: Mr L. Griffiths Trophy Best Gross score

Mrs G. Owen Salver Best Nett score

Mrs G. Owen Salver Best Nett score

West Bromwich Bowl Awarded to player with the best aggregate NETT score

of the Spring and Autumn Strokeplay Meetings.

7.7 Mixed Greensome Strokeplay

Date: Usually on a weekend in late September

Format: Greensome Strokeplay - Men - White tees; Ladies - Red Tees Each player must

be an amateur golfer having an official WHS Handicap Index of not more than 36.0 for Men or Ladies; Combined Course Handicap: 60% of Lowest Course

Handicap plus 40% of Higher Course Handicap

Scoring: Gross score & Best nett score (gross less partnership's Course Handicap allowance)

Prizes: Best Gross - Lady & Gentleman;

Best Nett - Lady & Gentleman;

Further prizes in relation to the number of entries received

Trophies: MWGA Best Gross Trophy Best Gross score

Gill Goodwin Shield Best Nett score

7.8 Autumn Teams of Three

Date: Usually on a weekend during October

Format: Teams of Three, Stableford - Handicap Allowance - 85% of Course Handicap for

each player

Scoring: Two best scores on each hole to count

Prizes: For best team of three and other prizes in relation to the number of entries received.

Trophy: No trophy

7.9 County Championship

Date: Over two days in April at a date to avoid other major competitions.

Format: 18 holes qualifying stroke play (Handicap Allowance - 95% of Course Handicap)

followed by Matchplay knockout (100% of Course Handicap)

Open to MWCGA Full Members with an official WHS Handicap Index of 20.0 or

less at the time of entry.

Entry limited to **24** competitors. In the event of entries exceeding this number, priority will be given to entrants with the lowest official WHS Handicap Index on the closing date for entries. The matchplay element will be limited to **16** players.

Registration: Players must register in person with the Championship organiser at the venue at

least 30 minutes before their notified tee time. Failure to do so will result in the

player forfeiting their place.

Players who do not wish or intend to play in the match play stages (Championship and Plate competitions) must declare the fact to the Championship organiser at the time of registration. Their strokeplay score will NOT be taken into account when determining the cut mark for the matchplay knockout stages.

Start Times: Players shall start at the times laid down by the Committee and in accordance

with the Rules of Golf. However if a player arrives at the starting point, ready to

play, no more than five minutes late, in the absence of exceptional

circumstances, the player must apply a general penalty (2 strokes in strokeplay and loss of 1 hole in matchplay). Otherwise the penalty for the breach of the

Rules is disqualification.

Buggies Use of a Buggy is NOT permitted, unless a competitor has received permission from

the County Captain or Competition organiser on the day and has a valid medical

certificate of disability.

Caddies Use of a caddie is permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf and provided

that the caddie is not a Professional golfer.

Day 1 AM 18 Hole Stroke Play.

Day 1 PM Best gross scores 1-8 qualify for the Championship Knockout draw

Best gross scores 9–16 qualify for the Championship Plate draw

Knockout ties: Knockout matches tied all square will be completed by a hole-by-hole play-

off which will take place immediately. Play-off holes and the number of holes to be played, to be determined by the Committee according to the course layout. In 2021 (Welshpool) the play off holes will be Holes 1 and 2 and Hole 12 repeated as

necessary.

Day 2 AM: Semi Finals - The Championship

Semi Finals - The Plate

Day 2 PM: Final - The Plate

Final - The Championship

Scoring: Gross score in qualifying round

In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided on the lowest score for the last 9,

6, 3 or 1 hole.

Cancellation Policy: In the event of the course being closed, due to weather conditions, the

competition may be restricted to one day only. In this event the County Champion

will be the player with the lowest gross score over 18 holes strokeplay.

Prizes: Best Gross in qualifying round

7.10 Mid Wales Girls' County & Open Championship

Date: Usually on a weekend during April

Format: Individual Strokeplay (Handicap Allowance applied of 95% of Course Handicap)

over 36 holes strokeplay comprising of one round of 18 holes strokeplay on each of

two days. Caddies are not permitted.

Open to players under the age of 18 on 1st January in the current year and with

official WHS Handicap Index of 36.0 or 28.0 or less at the time of entry.

Entries limited to 30 competitors. In the event of entries exceeding this number, priority will be given to Full Members of MWCGA and thereafter players with the

lowest exact handicap on the closing date for entries.

Ties: In the event of a tie after two rounds, the winner of the Championship will be

decided by the lowest score for the last 18 holes (or the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes). If the ties still arises, the scores for the 1st round shall be treated in the same way until a

decision is reached.

Scoring: Gross score

Cancellation Policy: In the event of a course being closed, due to weather conditions, the

competition may be restricted to one day only. In this event the County Champion

will be the player with the lowest gross score over 18 holes strokeplay.

Prizes: Best Gross and prizes in proportion to the number of entries

Best Nett –after Handicap Allowance applied of 95% Course Handicap

Trophies: Rees Evans Trophy Mid Wales Girls' Open Champion, Best Gross

Anna Hubbard Trophy Mid Wales Girls' County Champion, Best Gross

Nett Prize Best Nett

8. HANDICAP LEAGUE

Date: To be played annually from March to August with the semi-finals and final in

September/October.

Format: Affiliated Clubs may enter one or more teams

Teams shall consist of a maximum of six players

Matchplay four-ball better ball with strokes to be allocated – Handicap Allowance

applied - 90% of the difference in Course Handicap.

Open to players who are Members of a MWCGA Affiliated Club who hold an official WHS Handicap Index (maximum 36.0). A player may only play for one Club and

one team, throughout the season.

Teams will be drawn into Divisions of three to five teams, dependent upon the number of teams entered. Matches will be played on a home and away basis.

Semi Finals and Finals will be played on a neutral course.

Scoring: Scoring for each pair will be:

Two points for a win or concession

One point for a halved match. The exception will be the finals, which shall be

played to a conclusion, until the winning team has been determined.

Full results of all Divisional matches to be returned to the MWCGA League organiser by 31 August each year

Competition Rules: A complete set of competition rules will be distributed to each Club that enters a team in the League and the rules will be published on the MWCGA website annually
